Nanotechnology in food

Nanotechnology is a powerful new technology for reconstructing nature at the atomic molecular level. It involves the study of materials, and the manipulation of structures, that exist at the nanoscale, <100 nanometres (nm) in size. Today various nanotech companies are working to fortify processed food with nano-encapsulated nutrients, its appearance and taste boosted by nano-developed colours, its fat and sugar content removed or disabled by nano-modification, and 'mouth feel' is also improved. Nanotechnology will also enable junk foods like ice cream and chocolate to be modified to reduce the amount of fats and sugars that the body can absorb. In this way, the nano industry could market vitamin and fibrefortified, fat and sugar-blocked junk food as health promoting and weight reducing.
